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2008 NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP ENTRY FORMS

This is the official entry form for the 2008 NSSA National Championships. Your combined Conference rating and Regional Championship result determines your National ranking and slot to the Nationals. Your National ranking can be viewed on the Conference ratings pages on the NSSA website. You must have competed in the both the mandatory number of events in your conference and the Regional Championships to have qualified for entry to the National Championships. National Championship slots for all divisions were posted at all Regional Championships. Please contact your conference director or email the National Office if you are unsure of the division slots.

There are four separate championships so please read the attached information pages very carefully regarding the dates, contest locations and academic rules. If you are an alternate, please read the alternate instructions carefully. The Thirtieth Annual National Championship Awards Banquet will be held on Sunday, June 29 at the Laguna Cliffs Marriott in Dana Point.

Please find attached the following and please read each page very carefully:

GENERAL INFORMATION FORMS; NSSA HOLD HARMLESS ENTRY FORM, NATIONAL AWARDS BANQUET ORDER FORM; COMMENTATOR SHEET.

Correct entry form, fees and report cards must received in the National Office no later than June 2, 2008. Report cards are required for all surfers competing in the National Interscholastic Championships, the National Open Championships and the National Explorer Championships (under 18 report card requirement in the Explorer). You will not be entered into the National Championships event unless your report card is included with your forms and fees. If entry is incomplete which includes form, fees and report card, your entry will be put into the incomplete file and you could lose your slot in the Nationals. **MAKE SURE ALL FEES, FORMS AND REPORT CARD ARE RECEIVED IN THE NSSA NATIONAL OFFICE BY JUNE 2.**

CONTEST SITES: The National Explorer Championships (preliminary rounds of all divisions) and Airshow will be held June 18-21 at Salt Creek. The National Explorer Championships will continue June 24-28 at Lower Trestles. The National Open Championships (all divisions) will be held June 24-28 at Lower Trestles. All Open and Explorer Finals will be held June 28 at Lower Trestles. **ENTRY/MAIL HINT:** Do not rely on anyone (including sponsors) to pay your entry fee but yourself. It could cost you a slot in the Nationals and we've seen it happen! Mail entry at least 7-10 working days in advance of the deadline date of **June 2, 2008** to make sure it reaches the National Office in time. If the deadline date is less than 10 days away, I advise that you use Fed Ex, Express/Priority Mail or something similar. **Mail to NSSA, P.O. Box 495, Huntington Beach, CA 92648. If using Fed Ex send to NSSA, 10031 Dana Drive, Huntington Beach, CA 92646. Don't forget to put in your report card!**

All dates and times are subject to change. Call the NSSA National Office at 714-378-0899 on or after June 9 for updated National Championships date and time information. Press line 4 for National Interscholastic Championship information, line 5 for National Open Championship information and line 6 for National Explorer Championship information. Or check the website at www.nssa.org and click on “Heat Times” for division times. After June 13 the National Office will be closed and all updated information will be posted at the event site.

LOCATION (PLEASE READ, VERY IMPORTANT) The National Interscholastic and Airshow Championships will be held at Salt Creek. The National Explorer Championships preliminary rounds of all divisions will be held at Salt Creek. The National Explorer Championships will continue at Lower Trestles. The National Open Championships will held at Lower Trestles. All Open and Explorer Finals will be held at Lower Trestles.

CONTEST INFORMATION/HEAT TIMES/CHECK IN: National Interscholastic, Airshow and Explorer competition at Salt Creek will begin at 6:30 am. National Open and Explorer competition at Lower Trestles will begin at 8:00 am. All competitors are responsible for checking the heat board each day for any and all updated information regarding the championships. All competitors must check in with the beach marshal no later than five minutes prior to their heat or they could be replaced by an alternate.

ACCESS TO LOWERS: Two shuttles will be provided for access to Lowers. Walking or loitering on the railroad tracks is prohibited. All individuals are required to follow the instructions of the State Park officials and the State Park signs posted. Anyone in violation of the State Park rules will be ticketed. Any NSSA member in violation of the State Park rules could risk suspension from the National Championships.

NSSA NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP COMPETITION RULES: The NSSA National Competition Rules as written in the 2007/08 rule book will apply for the National Championships.

ENTRY FEES, FORMS AND REPORT CARDS: Entry fees, forms and report cards are due in the National Office by June 2, 2008-fees payable to the NSSA as follows. Mail to NSSA, P.O. Box 495, Huntington Beach, CA 92648. If using Federal Express send to NSSA, 10031 Dana Drive, Huntington Beach, CA 92646. After June 2, alternates will be placed in the event if and where space is available. Late fees will apply for all entries received after June 2. Forms without fees or report cards will not be accepted. Faxed forms are not accepted.

ENTRY INFORMATION AND DEADLINE: Each hold harmless entry form must be completely filled out and signed by the competitor and legal guardian (if under 18). Completed entry form, fees and report card to be sent to the NSSA National Office, P.O. Box 495, Huntington Beach, CA 92648 and arrive in the National Office by the deadline date of June 2, 2008. If using Federal Express send to NSSA, 10031 Dana Drive, Huntington Beach, CA 92646. **IF ENTRY FORM IS NOT COMPLETE INCLUDING CORRECT FEES AND REPORT CARD, THE ENTRY WILL BE PLACED IN THE INCOMPLETE FILE AND COMPETITOR COULD LOSE HIS/HER SLOT IF PROPER ENTRY IS NOT RECEIVED BY THE DEADLINE DATE.** Because of the necessity of getting the correct entry information by the deadline date, **DO NO RELY ON SPONSORS OR COMPANIES TO PAY ENTRY FEES. DO NOT SEND FORMS WITHOUT FEES ATTACHED.** If your fees and report card are not in the National Office by the deadline date, you will not be entered into the event and an alternate will replace you. **FAXED ENTRY FORMS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**

ALTERNATES: All alternates who have their completed entry form, fees and report card submitted by the deadline date of June 2 will be put into the event **if and where** space is available on June 3. Alternates fill in for their own conferences and will be selected according to their 2008 National ranking. Alternates may email the NSSA National Office jaragon@nssa.org on or after June 4 to confirm if entry was accepted. Alternate entries that are not accepted will be refunded per email request. **PLEASE BE AWARE THAT ALTERNATE SLOTS MAY OR MAY NOT BECOME AVAILABLE BUT YOU ARE WELCOME TO TRY.**

LATE ENTRIES: Late entries will be accepted after June 2 on a first come, first serve basis, if and where space is available (**very few, if any late entries make it in**). Money orders or cash only will be accepted after the deadline date of June 2.

BOUNCED CHECKS: There will be a \$25.00 fee for any bounced checks and fees must be replaced by money order.

REFUNDS: Absolutely no refunds unless a doctors note is presented for injury or illness. Please notify the National Office immediately if you cannot participate due to injury or illness so alternates can be entered.

ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS-PLEASE READ CAREFULLY: It is mandatory that all contestants competing in the **NATIONAL INTERSCHOLASTIC CHAMPIONSHIPS AND THE NATIONAL OPEN CHAMPIONSHIPS** submit a copy of his/her report card from the most recent formal grading period of the 2007/08 school year (1st semester or 3rd or 4th quarter) with the entry form. It is mandatory that all contestants under 18 competing in the **NATIONAL EXPLORER CHAMPIONSHIPS** submit a copy of his/her report card from the most recent formal grading period of the 2007/08 school year (1st semester or 3rd or 4th quarter). Report card must show that contestant was considered by his/her institution as a full time student carrying a minimum 2.0 GPA during the 2007/08 school year. College students must be enrolled in a minimum two academic classes and carrying a minimum 2.0 GPA. **REQUIRED REPORT CARD FOR OPEN, EXPLORER AND INTERSCHOLASTIC CHAMPIONSHIPS MUST BE SUBMITTED WITH THE ENTRY FORM BEFORE THE COMPETITOR IS ENTERED INTO THE CHAMPIONSHIPS. NO EXCEPTIONS.**
