2017 NSSA NATIONAL INTERSCHOLASTIC CHAMPIONSHIPS

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY- COACHES/CAPTAINS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THIS INFORMATION

The National **High School Varsity, Junior Varsity and Middle School Championships** will be held June 17-18 at Salt Creek. The National **College Championships** will be held June 19th at Salt Creek. Entry fee for the 2017 NSSA National Interscholastic Championships is \$650.00 per team. Each team member is required to be a current NSSA, NSSA Jr. or NSSA Interscholastic member. Each team member must submit a report card from the most recent formal grading period (**1ST semester, 3rd or 4th quarter is acceptable**) of the 2016/17 school year. Team entry form, fees and report cards must be received by the NSSA National Office by the deadline date of June 1, 2017. All incomplete and late entries submitted after June 2 will be charged with the late fee of \$680.00 per team. NO EXCEPTIONS. Please mail all forms, fees and report cards to NSSA, P.O.Box 495, Huntington Beach, CA 92648. **DO NOT SEND FORMS WITHOUT FEES AND REPORT CARDS ATTACHED.**

MUST BE INCLUDED FOR ENTRY TO THE NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS

- Team member list in seeding order and any eligible alternates. **VERY IMPORTANT: Alternates MUST be listed on the team entry form by the deadline date of June 1. Alternates cannot be listed on the team alternate list after the deadline date.** Alternates that are listed on the team alternate list can be substituted into the event any time prior to the first round of the event.
- Entry fee of \$650.00 per team. After June 1, entry fee is \$680.00 per team.
- Report card from each team member including alternates.

TEAM MEMBER PARTICIPATION RULES

- Team member participation rules for the Interscholastic Championships are required and must be followed according to the NSSA competition rules.
- All teams must be recognized and in good standing with the school they are competing for. The NSSA will honor each school district's eligibility rules for team participation.
- NSSA National academic rules require all College, High School and Middle School team competitors carry a minimum 2.0 GPA to be eligible to participate.
- **Team member must be current NSSA, NSSA Jr or NSSA Interscholastic members in order to compete.**
- All classmen are eligible for both the Varsity and Junior Varsity teams. A team member can only compete on one team-either the Varsity or Junior Varsity in the same event.
- **All alternates must be listed on the team entry form with a report card by the deadline date of June 1. Alternates will not be permitted to be added to the team alternate list after the deadline date of June 1.**

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY: ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR TEAM MEMBERS ON SCHOOL TEAM WHO ARE ATTENDING PRIVATE, INDEPENDENT AND HOMESCHOOL.

Students attending private, independent or home school may be eligible for team participation with school administrative approval and/or district level approval. A letter must be submitted on letterhead as follows: (1) Letter must be submitted on school letterhead from the participating school's principal and/or administrator stating approval that student may compete on the team. (2) Letter must be submitted on school district letterhead from an appropriate school district official stating that the student has approval from the district to compete for the school team.

This eligibility letter MUST be submitted by the deadline date of June 1 if a team member or alternate team member falls into this category. Team member eligibility letters will not be accepted after the deadline date of June 1.

NATIONAL INTERSCHOLASTIC CHAMPIONSHIPS AWARDS INFORMATION

The 2017 National High School and Middle School Championship awards will be announced immediately following the finals on June 18 on the Championship Podium at Salt Creek.

The 2017 National Interscholastic Collegiate Championship awards will be announced immediately following the collegiate finals on June 19 on the Championship Podium at Salt Creek.

CODE OF CONDUCT: NSSA members, coaches, parents and spectators are expected to uphold high standards of integrity and behavior and conduct themselves at all times in a sportsmanlike manner. Any disregard of the NSSA rules and/or display of unsportsmanlike conduct by any team member, coach, parent or spectator may result in disqualification of a team in the National Interscholastic Championships. Sportsmanlike conduct includes showing respect toward all who are in attendance at the event: officials, coaches, team members, opponents, parents and spectators. Unsportsmanlike conduct includes inappropriate behavior in language, gesture, or action which demeans, physically intimidates, or endangers others any time during the event.

NSSA NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP COMPETITION RULES: The NSSA National Competition Rules as written in the 2016/17 rule book will apply for the National Championships.

ENTRY FEES, FORMS AND REPORT CARDS: Entry fees, forms and report cards are due in the National Office by June 1, 2017-fees payable to the NSSA as follows. Mail to NSSA, P.O. Box 495, Huntington Beach, CA 92648. Late fees will apply for all entries received after June 1. Forms without fees or report cards will not be accepted.

LATE ENTRY FEE (received by NSSA after June 1, 2017)-----\$680.00 per team

MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS: Team member must be current NSSA, NSSA Jr or NSSA Interscholastic members in order to compete. Team members will not be placed into a heat until their membership is current. Membership forms can be obtained from the National Office.

ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS-PLEASE READ CAREFULLY: It is mandatory that all team members including alternates competing in the **NATIONAL INTERSCHOLASTIC CHAMPIONSHIPS** submit a copy of his/her report card from the most recent formal grading period of the 2016/17 school year (**1st semester or 3rd or 4th quarter is acceptable**) with the entry form. Report card must show that contestant was considered by his/her institution as a full time student carrying a minimum 2.0 GPA during the 2016/17 school year. College students must be enrolled in a minimum two academic classes and carrying a minimum 2.0 GPA. **REQUIRED REPORT CARD FOR ALL TEAM MEMBERS AND ALTERNATES MUST BE SUBMITTED WITH THE TEAM ENTRY FORM BY THE DEADLINE DATE OF JUNE 1. NO EXCEPTIONS.**
